EXT. A FOREST.

AFTERNOON, LATE DECEMBER.

SFX Wind in leafless trees. Creaking of branches. Winter birds, such as the robin. The patter of four feet, sounds of snuffling and sniffing in the undergrowth.

1 PUPPY: (Sniffs) What's that? (Sniffs and snuffles - hopefully) No, not

food. (*Moves on... sniffs*) What's that? (*Big sniff*) A dog came by here. A stranger - a female dog, not one of my pack. Oh, where are they? Where can they be? (*Whimpers*) It will be getting dark

soon. I'll never find them.

SFX A howl in the distance – a wild dog.

2 PUPPY: What was that? Was that them? (A little puppy howl) Help!

I'm hungry. So hungry! Please find me! Please...

SFX A school bell in the distance.



INT. A CLASSROOM, IN A HIGH SCHOOL

SFX School bell

1 MR SIMMONS: Right everyone, that's it. Off you go – have a good Christmas.

SFX Kids packing up, chattering.

2 MR SIMMONS: Lily – don't forget, you've got detention.

3 LILY: Aw Sir – I thought you'd let me off.

4 MR SIMMONS: You were talking in my lesson.

5 LILY: You were teaching in my conversation!

6 MR SIMMONS: Detention, Lily.

7 LILY: It's so boring.

8 MR SIMMONS: Lily...

9 LILY: It's Christmas.

10 MR SIMMONS: Now!

Lily angrily storms out of the classroom.



INT. SCHOOL CORRIDOR.

CONTINUOUS

SFX A busy school corridor to detention. Lots of other kids around – saying goodbye for the holidays. Teachers' voices, wishing everyone Happy Christmas.

1 LILY: (Bumping into someone) Oi – get out my way!

2 GIRL: (Calls over) Hey, Lily! We're going to get some chips. Wanna

come?

3 LILY: Can't. Got detention.

4 GIRL: What? It's Christmas!

5 LILY: Tell me about it!

SFX Lily arrives at the room for detention – knocks.

SFX Door opens.

6 TEACHER: Ah – Lily.

7 LILY Miss (Mr) Simmons sent me.

8 TEACHER: What did you do?

9 LILY: Dunno.

10 TEACHER: In you come.

SFX Lily goes into the detention room.



EXT. THE FOREST

A SHORT WHILE LATER.

SFX Puppy paws and snuffling.

1 PUPPY: Almost dark. Lots of unfamiliar smells. I don't like it.

I'm scared. (Whimpers and howls)





DETENTION

HALF AN HOUR LATER.

SFX Clock ticking.

1 BOY #1: How much longer, Miss?

2 TEACHER: Not long,

3 LILY Miss, I'm BORED!

4 TEACHER: Be quiet Lily.

SFX Rocking on chairs.

5 LILY: Don't you want to get home too, Miss?

6 TEACHER: As a matter of fact, I do! Sitting in detention with you lot is not

my idea of festive fun.

7 BOY #2: Can we go then?

8 BOY #1: Please!

9 TEACHER: Go on then. Off you go.

10 ALL: Yesss!

11 LILY: I'm out of here!



FOREST.

A SHORT WHILE LATER.

SFX Wind, creaking branches.

Lily walking, kicking up the leaves - she's cold.

SFX Lily's phone rings, she answers.

1 LILY: Hi Mum.

2 MUM: Lily, where are you?

3 LILY: I went for some chips.

4 MUM: Your Nan is here, with your Auntie. They've come to exchange

Christmas presents.

5 LILY: Oh – not the weird twins too!

6 MUM: Yes, your cousins are here as well. Have you forgotten?

7 LILY No. I was just hungry and I wanted some chips. I'm coming

home now. I've cut through the woods, so I won't be long.

8 MUM: How many times have I told you not to come through the

woods after dark.

9 LILY: It's fine Mum. Stop fussing. I'll be home in a few minutes.

10 MUM: All right all right!

SFX Lily puts the phone down, with a sigh of frustration.

SFX Lily sets off running.

SFX Lily trips.

11 LILY: Woah!

SFX Lily falls with a thump.



THE SAME.

A FEW MOMENTS LATER.

SFX Puppy panting and licking.

1 LILY: (A bit dazed) What? Oh – hello little puppy! You're cute. No – no

- don't lick my face.

2 PUPPY: Sorry.

3 LILY: What?

4 PUPPY: I saw you trip and fall. Are you hurt?

5 LILY: Y...eah! I must be.

6 PUPPY: Where does it hurt?

7 LILY: I think I banged my head. I must have banged my head; cos I

think you're talking to me.

8 PUPPY: I am.

9 LILY: You're a dog.

10 PUPPY: Actually I'm a Torgo-Chien.

11 LILY: A what?

12 PUPPY: I got separated from my pack. (Whimpers) And now I'm all

alone, and I'm scared, and I'm hungry.

13 LILY: I can get some food for you – at my house.

14 PUPPY: Can I come with you?

15 LILY: Yeah. I'll have to sneak you in. Can you squeeze into my rucksack.

16 PUPPY: Thank you.

SFX Puppy climbs in the ruck sack.

17 LILY: All set?

18 PUPPY: Yes. (Woof)

19 LILY: Let's go!



INT. LILY'S HOUSE, LIVING ROOM.

10 MINUTES LATER.

1 NAN: Where's Lily got to?

2 MUM: I phoned her. She's on her way.

3 TWINS: Lily's late!

4 AUNTIE: She forgot about us, didn't she.

5 MUM: Of course not. She was saying goodbye to her friends.

6 AUNTIE The twins always come straight home.

7 TWINS: We don't need any friends.

8 NAN: You have each other.

9 TWINS: Yes, Nanny. We do.

SFX (Off) The sound of the front door opening.

10 MUM: Ah – that's her now.

SFX (Off) Door closes.

11 MUM: In here, Lily!

12 LILY: (Coming into the room) Hi everyone. Happy Christmas!

13 TWINS / NAN / AUNTIE: Happy Christmas, Lily!

Pause.

14 MUM: Why don't you put your bag down, Lily, and come right in.

15 LILY: I'm hungry. I'm just gonna go make a pot noodle.

16 NAN: She's hungry.

17 AUNTIE: We brought mince pies.

18 TWINS We made them.

19 LILY: Sorry. Don't like mince pies. (Exiting) Won't be long.

20 AUNTIE: Well really.



1 NAN: How rude!

2 MUM: (Exiting) I'll go and get her.

3 TWINS: Doesn't like mince pies? That's weird.





INT. THE KITCHEN.

CONTINUOUS.

SFX Lily flicks the kettle on and peels the lid back on a pot noodle.

1 MUM: (Entering) Lily, what are you doing?

2 LILY: Making a pot noodle.

3 MUM: I thought you had some chips.

4 LILY: I lied. I got detention. Sorry.

5 MUM: Oh Lily.

6 LILY: Talking in maths. It was nothing. You go back to the living room,

Mum. I won't be long.

7 MUM: (Little shriek) Lily! Your rucksack just moved.

8 LILY: No it didn't.

9 MUM: Look! Look! It did it again. It's alive. Is there something in there?

10 LILY: No Mum. Mum, don't...

SFX Mum unzips the rucksack.

11 PUPPY: Woof!

12 MUM: What's this?

13 LILY: It's not what it looks like.

14 MUM: It looks like a puppy.

15 LILY: A magical puppy.

16 TWINS: (Entering) Lily has a puppy.

17 PUPPY: (Whimpers and runs)

18 LILY: Don't scare him!

19 TWINS: We didn't.

20 LILY: Of course you did. You scare me!



INT. LIVING ROOM.

CONTINUOUS.

SFX Puppy panting, whimpering.

1 NAN Oh! There's a puppy.

2 LILY Here boy, don't be scared.

3 AUNTIE: I didn't know you had a puppy.

4 MUM: Neither did I!

5 LILY: I found him in the woods.

6 MUM: You can't keep him. We need to take him somewhere – to the

RSPCA.

7 LILY: But he's special. He can talk.

8 AUNTIE: Oh really!

9 LILY: He can. (To the puppy) Go on, say something.

10 PUPPY: Woof!

11 LILY: No – talk! Like you did in the woods.

12 AUNTIE: This is ridiculous.

13 PUPPY: (Whimpers)

14 LILY: Go on. Say something.

15 PUPPY: (Whimpers and builds up to a wine, then a full puppy howl)

SFX The puppy's howl is met with a big wolf howl from the garden.

16 MUM: What was that.

17 AUNTIE Look! Out there. On the front garden. In the road.

18 NAN: Wolves!

SFX More howling!

19 LILY: It must be his pack.

20 PUPPY: (Howls)



1 LILY: They've come for him.

2 MUM: What do you mean?

3 TWINS: Let him out. Let him out.

SFX The Twins run out of the room.

4 MUM: No, stop! Don't open the front door!

SFX (Off) Front door opening.

SFX (Off) A large wolf comes tearing in.

5 TWINS: (Off) Arrghh!!!

SFX General pandemonium in the room. The barking of the wolf, the yapping of the puppy. Crashing of glass.

6 MUM: My best vase.

SFX A rattling.

7 MUM: No! Not the Christmas tree!

SFX Christmas tree crashes to the floor.

SFX The wolf stands, snarling...

8 LILY: I didn't hurt your puppy. See! I only wanted to feed him.

Please don't take him.

SFX: Wolf howls. Puppy howls and yelps as he is grabbed by the wolf.

9 LILY: Put him down!

SFX Wolf turns and runs.

10 LILY: Come back!

11 MUM: Let them go.

12 LILY: (Chasing after them) Come back!

13 MUM: Don't go after them – Lily! Just stay here, everyone. I'll go after her.

SFX Mum runs off after Lily.

14 TWINS: Would anyone like a mince pie?



EXT. THE FOREST

A FEW MINUTES LATER

SFX Lily arrives in the forest, out of breath. Mum not far behind.

1 MUM: (Off) Lily, wait! Come back.

2 LILY: Where did they go?

3 MUM: (Arriving, out of breath) Leave it, Lily. He's gone.

4 LILY: I just wanted to explain. I wouldn't have hurt him.

5 MUM: You can't explain to a pack of wolves.

6 LILY: But they weren't ordinary wolves.

7 MUM: Lily, you had a bang on the head. Dogs can't talk.

8 WOLF: Yes we can. But only in the forest.

9 MUM: Well, I never!

10 LILY: Do you believe me now, Mum?

11 WOLF: You stole our puppy!

12 LILY: He was lost and hungry. I only took him home for a pot noodle.

13 PUPPY: It's true. I asked if I could go with her.

14 LILY: I didn't kidnap him.

15 WOLF: So why have you followed us.

16 LILY: I just want to say a proper goodbye. I thought we were friends.

17 PUPPY: We are.

18 LILY: You are so cute!

SFX Puppy runs to Lily. She fusses him, laughing.

19 MUM: Don't let him lick your face Lily. It's not hygienic.

20 PUPPY: I wish I could stay with you.

21 LILY: You belong with your pack in the forest.



1 PUPPY: But I feel at home with you. You're my friend.

2 WOLF: Do you really want to stay with the humans?

3 PUPPY: I do.

4 WOLF: You lose the power of speech in the town.

5 PUPPY: We can come for long walks in the forest.

6 LILY: Mum? What do you say?

7 MUM: I don't know...

8 PUPPY: Please!

9 MUM: How do you say no to a magical talking puppy?

10 WOLF: Are you sure, my son?

11 PUPPY: I'm sure.

12 WOLF: Very well then.

13 LILY: Oh - this is the best Christmas present ever.

14 MUM: Christmas! We need to get back. Your Auntie and your Nan are

waiting.

15 PUPPY: And those strange children.

16 LILY: They're my cousins. You get used to them.

17 MUM: You can introduce your puppy properly this time.

18 LILY: Yes.

19 MUM: So you'd better give him a name.

20 PUPPY: I've got a name. It's (dog noises).

21 LILY: Sorry – you need a human name.

22 PUPPY: Then what shall I be called?

23 LILY: That's easy, I've known all along. Your name is... Eddie!

24 PUPPY: Eddie.

25 LILY: Yes. Happy Christmas, Eddie!
