LEARNING OUTCOMES. -

- Develop CHARACTERS using sound and voices (CHARACTERISATION).
- PREPARE an audio script for RECORDING (last minute changes)
- REHEARSE a script for recording.

Casting & Characterisation - 30 minutes

Teacher allocates parts. For further guidance, see CASTING WORKSHEET

Work with the children as a group to explore how the characters might be performed. Consider:

- Facts: age, gender, species.
- o Motivation what does the character want?
- Characteristics clues in the script to character.

Portraying the character through sound.

- o Age
- Accent
- Pitch (high / low)
- Speed (fast / slow)
- Are there any non-verbal vocalisations: coughing, sneezing, burping, sniffing, sighing, screaming, laughing. In this drama, also: growling, howling, barking, whimpering.

Readthrough the Script - 30 minutes

• Rehearse the script, with any final changes – including finalising the TITLE.
